Eaton:

Wildflower Areas:

It was suggested that the recreational field would be suitable areas and it was agreed to discuss this with the Eaton Community Park Association, it was also agreed the wildflower area in the cemetery needed refreshing and could possibly be expanded.

An email from Helen Smith had been received regarding the use of the Councils land and suggesting it could be put to better use, the Clerk was asked to reply and explain the history of the Councils land.

Street Light outside 3/5 Waltham Lane:

Western Distribution had advised they had been instructed to remove their timber pole from the land adjacent to above properties which meant the Parish Councils street light would not viable as it is attached to their pole. As this is a pole bracket light it would need to be replaced with a lighting column and a new power supply would be required.

Several street signs need replacing and the Clerk suggested he be given a list of which ones along with photographs.
