Eaton:

a) Herbage Charity

b) Churchyard:

After discussion it was agreed a site meeting was needed to agree what work needed doing, also it was agreed the matter of the Parish Councils responsibilities in relation to the Churchyard needed to be clarified

c) Saplings

The offer of saplings was discussed and after discussion it was agreed to wait until rainy weather arrived and in the meantime decide where they would be located, the community play area being one suggestion.

a) Village Tidy

Goadby Marwood:

a) Speeding Traffic

The Council had received several complaints regarding speeding traffic entering the village and it was unanimously agreed the Council should look into ways of raising awareness of the 30 mph speed limit. It was suggested gates similar to Eastwell and improved road markings might help, an approach to Highways to be made for advice.
